Our building comes under Heritage listing and ALL repair work must comply with Heritage Victoria.

The building was assessed in in 2018 and the engineers report detailed extensive work was required to address the problem of rising damp, due to the high cost of the work required, nothing has been done. We are now at a point where the damage requires urgent attention, it could pose a health and safety risk in the near future and without remedial work the building will be compromised.

We are seeking the assistance of someone who would be in a position to take on this problem and work on a strategic plan of action. This would require arranging new assessments of the building and costs of remedial work. Once this has been done then we would have to approach Heritage Victoria about funding as the Art Society does not have the means to cover such a large project.


